NKNA Porch Flags – Darius Ali has volunteered to take over the flag project and is ready to start taking orders. Cost will be \$45 for each flag. Those members who already paid \$30 for a flag (before the vendor ceased to make them) will be comped the annual membership dues, but will still need to pay the \$15 difference to get a new flag. Based on the number of already paid for flags, and new orders, Joan will place an initial order for approx. 25 flags to be distributed at the Feb. monthly meeting.
